Sun Safe in Carle Place

The theme to this year's popular Battle of the Classes at Carle Place High School was "Be sun safe. Be sun smart!" The annual tournament pits the four grades against each other in a fun athletic and academic competition, while students raise money for a different charity selected by the kids each year. The nonprofit the students selected this year is the Colette Coyne Melanoma Awareness Campaign, a Long Island-based skin cancer awareness organization. To help encourage their charitable efforts and boost the money the charity receives, Altice Connects' Charity Champions provided seed money for their fund-raising activities as well as a \$1,000 donation to the Campaign. This is Carle Places second year in the program.
