Pompe disease is a rare, inherited condition that affects multiple organ systems due to a buildup of glycogen in the body. Money raised will help advance research, develop new therapies and to improve the quality of life

for patients. This charity was chosen by the students, who were inspired by the story of district employee Roseann and John Favicchia's granddaughter Sophia, who is impacted by this disease. This year's event will take place on Friday, Feb. 28.
